The VOC was founded in October 2001 and is located in the Shatila Palestinian Refugee Camp at the southern outskirts of Beirut. It was initiated by a group of AUB medical and non-medical students, who were concerned about providing medical care to people living in underserved areas of the city. Since then, volunteers from various Lebanese educational institutions, such as Lebanese American University, Beirut Arab University, Balamand University, and Lebanese University, have joined the VOC team. The volunteers include medical doctors, dentists, pharmacists, nutritionists, nurses, engineers, and people from other fields of work. Volunteers receive no salary and operate the clinic once a week, on Saturday mornings, providing regular care to over 200 patients.
